- (a) FREE food while schools are closed to ensure students who rely on our schools for breakfast and lunch continue to receive that service. This program will be solely for pick-up meals. Meals cannot be consumed on site. Be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19. Youth must be present to receive the meals
- (b) No applications or membership are required. Students Only

The United States Department of Agriculture contracts with CANV's Food Bank to administer 8 to 10 food staples to low-income Napa County residents once a month from 8 locations. Items typically include peanut butter, cereal, canned fruits and vegetables, pasta and canned meats. NOTE – Napa Residents may only access one of the two sites. (USDA) commodities for distribution to eligible individuals and households within their respective service areas. In order to be eligible for USDA commodities, an individual or household must reside in the geographical area being served and meet established income guidelines.

Meals on Wheels for Seniors Please have any senior that is in need of meal delivery to visit our website www.canv.org and download the application (English or Spanish). Please complete the application and send back to my email or fax. Home delivered meals will begin the following delivery day upon receipt of completed application. Please be advised our delivery days are Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Senior Brown Bag Program -Enables seniors age 60 or older to remain independent as long as possible by giving them a "Brown Bag" with approximately 10 to 14 food items twice a month. Items may include fresh fruit, canned vegetables, oatmeal, bottled beverages, pasta and canned meat. Seniors pick up Brown Bags from 11 sites throughout Napa County, or volunteer drivers deliver food to those who are infirm or disabled.

Food Bank has received an exemption from the State of California to allow non-signature. The participant (or regular proxy) signature is temporarily not required to receive the Emergency Food Assistance Program foods.
