



Live Healthy Napa County (LHNC) seeks to promote and protect the health and wellbeing of every member of the community by bringing together diverse partners to:

In February, the following issues were identified as areas or domains with the greatest opportunity for improvement in both the LHNC Community Health Assessment process and the community engagement process conducted as part of Napa County’s Strategic Plan.

- Respect and Social Inclusion
- Food Insecurity
- Housing
- Transportation

May’s convening focused on the Respect and Social Inclusion (RSI) domain: Participants went over the timeline and objectives of our current Community Health Improvement Plan process, were presented with proposed RSI measures, objectives and goals. LHNC backbone staff also shared an RSI Organizational Checklist with participants. As we work to design actions within our CHIP, this is a tool that organizations can use to immediately and continuously improve RSI internally.

Attendees then participated in an Asset Based Community Development (ABCD) workshop. Asset mapping is a process for identifying and connecting resources to better achieve goals based on what we already have and/or have access to. Participants looked at community assets (Individuals, Associations, Institutions, Physical, Exchange, Culture), and how they can be connected and aligned for increasing RSI.
