

## CHNA PRIORITIZATION SESSION NOTES: AUGUST 23, 2023

This year, Providence Queen of the Valley Medical Center and Napa County HHSA have partnered to create a shared Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA). A CHNA collects qualitative and quantitative health data from across the county in order to create a point-in-time report of community health and determine health priorities for the next 3-5 years. We convened over 230 community members for listening sessions, key informant interviews and prioritization meetings in order to identify 5 health priorities, listed below. - Racial Equity and LGBTQ Inclusion
- Behavioral Health
- Housing
- Access to Health Services
- Economic Stability



Next, community partners will take the identified health priority areas and formulate goals, strategies and an action plan related to those issues. The result is a Community Health Improvement Plan, and subsequent Community Health Action Plan. This process requires, and centers, the continued expertise and feedback of community members.

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At our August 2023 CHNA prioritization session, over 90 community partners convened in person, and remotely, to select 3-5 priority areas for the upcoming Community Health Needs Assessment. Participants learned about the data collection process, reviewed qualitative and quantitative data, recorded existing work and “how might we” statements for each health theme, and selected their top three health themes.

### **Data collection process:**

Our data collection process was designed to understand the personal lived experience of community members. We support individuals to take the lead in surfacing bright spots and challenges in their quality of life and related health and wellbeing. We created open-ended discussions using interactive field materials to delve more deeply into themes about health and wellbeing. We focused our engagement on community groups whose voices are often underrepresented or unheard in public discourse. We also engaged community leaders working in both paid and unpaid capacities. Listening session participants live in American Canyon, Calistoga, Napa, St. Helena, and Yountville. Key informant session participants serve all areas of Napa County. In total, we met with 137 individuals.

- Community Member Listening Sessions: 16 Small group sessions
  - 11 English language sessions, 5 Spanish Language sessions
  - 112 Individuals total
- Key Informant sessions: 12 individual sessions, 7 group sessions
  - 25 Individuals total

**Qualitative and Quantitative Data:**

We identified 10 health themes from our qualitative data collection process, listed below. Each theme was presented with accompanying quantitative data, using local data whenever possible. Please review our presentation slide deck for full qualitative and quantitative information here.
